1. What immediately follows the stoning of Stephen? (vv. 1b–2)
  
2. We last saw Saul approving of Stephen's death (8:1a). What is he doing now? (v. 3; 9:1; 26:10; • \* 1 Tim. 1:13)
  
3. Up to now, only the leaders of the church have experienced persecution. Now it extends to all the believers.
  - a. What do the scattered believers do? (v. 4)
  
  - b. Compare 8:1b with 1:8. What do you notice?
  
4. God has been leading and empowering his people through the Holy Spirit. Whom does he now use to direct Philip? (v. 26)
  
5. Describe the man Philip meets. (v. 27)
  
6. As a foreigner and a eunuch, this man was forbidden by the Law from entering the assembly of the Lord (Deut. 23:1). Read Isaiah 56:1–8. What has God promised to a man like this?
  
7. How does the Ethiopian respond to Philip's message? (vv. 36–39)
  
8. How does the story of the Ethiopian eunuch clearly demonstrate God's unfolding plan? (Rom. 16:25–27, Eph. 3:4–6)
